We will now be asking that the booster injection must be given within 6 months prior to the competition. Anyone arriving without a passport or an up to date vaccination will be asked to leave the show ground.

#### Rules

- 1. All persons entering the show ground agrees to these rules and regulations.
- 2. The organisers do not accept liability for damage, any accident or injury of any kind to any person, animal or property whatsoever.
- 3. The judge's decision is final.
- 4. The show and its judging will be run under British Dressage rules.
- 5. Entry fees will not be refunded after midday on the closing date unless a valid veterinary certificate is produced.
- 6. No horse or pony may be entered into the same class more than once.
- 7. Any competitor who, in the eyes of the judge or member of the organising committee, treats or causes unnecessary suffering to any horse or pony will be asked to leave the showground.
- 8. Competition dress must be worn at all times including hard hat.
- 9. Objections must be made in writing and given to the Secretary within 15 minutes of the incident with a deposit of £10.00, which will be returned if the objection is upheld.
- 10. No horse or pony under the age of 4 years to be competed.
- 11. No lunging or galloping in the warm up arena.
- 12. The organisers reserve the right to cancel classes, withhold or reduce prize money if there are insufficient entries.
- 13. No dogs permitted on the yard.
- 14. Please tidy up after your horse in the lorry park.
